BM Trada Surveillance Audit

It is now 5 months after the historic change, and the dust seems to be settling down a bit. The new ministers are slowly but surely moving into their roles, and this is expected as their new roles and positions require them to go through a sharp learning curve. Unfortunately, projects from the government continues to be non-existent and indications are that things will only start reverting to normal early next year. Again, this is expected, as new stakeholders come in and the entire process is revamped such as signatories, decision-making processes, SOPs, new KPIs, etc. National finances are also challenging as more and more news flow out. Seems like our GST refunds and income tax refunds have gone missing from the system, which will impact small-medium companies with tight cash flows. Our "new" 93 year old Prime Minister is shaking up the world at the UN gathering and visits to China with talks of new economic colonization and not yielding to the might of stronger nations, and of course, we might possibly have a 3rd national car!

While the government machinery settles down and iron out their creases, we have embarked on our "Stop Gap" strategy of seeking private projects and embarking on our internal projects. In the past quarter, LLC Infra has secured the foundation works for the Malacca Power Plant project from Hyundai as well as the RAPID road project from Petronas. LLC Properties has also kick started the foundation works for our own Panorama Residences, Kelana Jaya development, and commenced SPA signing with the purchasers. Meanwhile, WET has been working hard to reach COD (Commercial Operation Date) for our pioneer 14MW Minihydro concession at Kerian, Perak, and is actively seeking out new M&E projects. Our cash balances continue to be strong, and we have taken the opportunity to pare down our borrowings to almost zero to save interest cost. All these actions are helping us weather through this tough period. Despite the securing of the above projects, the management is continuing to work hard to identify more opportunities and secure more projects. I hope I will have more new projects to announce by the end of this year with the hard-work-of everyone!

This year's financial numbers will definitely be challenging as any new projects that we secure will only start contributing for next year numbers. It is my belief that once the government settles down, new projects will emerge at a significant pace as these projects would have been delayed by almost a year. This coupled with less competition due to small-medium companies affected by the lack of jobs and tight cash flows will provide LLC Berhad Group with many opportunities. During this slow period, I regrest that all colleagues continue to be prudent and for those with some free time on their hands, to take the opportunity to rest before the action begins next year!
